Our DPM-Cambodia Director, Huy, recently sent us the following report on training pastors and prison ministry:

Training the Trainers

It is always our joy to share Derek's Khmer-language resources with local pastors so they are well-equipped to serve in their own community. Thirty pastors from 15 churches in the Takeo province attended the training sessions and all were very happy to receive such good teaching material. Topics included *Extravagant Love*; *Praying for the Government*; *What's So Important About the Cross?* and proclamation (using the proclamation cards). Each pastor received 10 sets of Derek's books and the proclamation cards to share with their church leaders. We also provided them with medical care (through a partner ministry) to ensure they are strong and healthy while serving the Lord.

Outreach to Prisoners

The Lord has opened up the doors for us to take His love and the message of salvation to prisoners. Some of the pastors who attended our training sessions also serve at the prison once a week. We shared the gospel with the prisoners and distributed Derek's book *What's So Important About the Cross?* Praise the Lord – most of the prisoners accepted Jesus as their Saviour!
