Working at Height and Harness Use Course Details

To cover Unit standards as follows:

- * Unit 23229 Use a safety harness for personal fall prevention when working at height (Level 3, 4 credits)

This training course covers:

1. Hazards associated with wearing a safety harness and associated equipment;
 - * Terminology
 - * Potential faults and non-compliance in personal equipment
 - * Primary hazards and associated control strategies
2. Safety harnesses and associated systems and equipment;
 - * Harness Systems
 - * Equipment
 - * Recording Requirements
3. Checking and fitting a safety harness;
 - * Identify parts
 - * Check for faults
 - * Inspection
 - * Fitting
4. Using a safety harness where a fall hazard exists at height;
 - * Choose and confirm the safety of anchor points
 - * Attaching lanyard
 - * Minimising risks
5. Recognising the requirements for rescue planning to be activated in the event of a fall;
 - * Rescue plan
 - * Roles of individuals in rescue plan

Overview/Purpose:

This course is designed for workers who are to complete basic work while under total restraint and recommended means of achieving competence. It is to enable a person to use a safety harness for personal fall prevention when working at height.

Who Should Attend:

Personnel required to wear a safety harness and work at heights.

Do you wear a harness for fall prevention where your anchor points are set up for you and safety plans including rescue are already in place? This is the course for you.

Special Notes:

Unit standard 23229 is the prerequisite for unit standard 15757 Use, install and disestablish temporary proprietary height safety systems when working at height. Persons qualified with unit 23229 are able to utilise basic fall arrest systems eg. Harnesses, lanyards and inertia reels. Those required to install, disestablish and identify anchor points for fall arrest systems as well as conduct rescues, should look at the greater level of training, unit standard 15757. (note: at this stage we do not run the 15757 unit standard).

Refreshers

Those requiring refreshers would attend this course at a reduced cost.
