



## ABOUT THE MOVIES

### **AQUAMAN (M) USA, Australia 2h23 Action, Adventure, Sci-Fi**

Reveals the origin story of half-human, half-Atlantean Arthur Curry and takes him on the journey of his lifetime—one that will not only force him to face who he really is, but to discover if he is worthy of his birth-right as King. Stars: Jason Momoa, Nicole Kidman and Temuera Morrison.

### **BOHEMIAN RHAPSODY (M) USA, UK 2h14 Drama, Biography**

A foot-stomping celebration of Queen and their extraordinary lead singer, Freddie Mercury. Their meteoric rise, near-implosion and reunion on the eve of Live Aid, as Mercury faces a life-threatening illness.

### **BUMBLEBEE (PG) 1h53 Action, Adventure, Science Fiction**

Travis Knight directs this Transformers spin-off centering around Bumblebee, set in 1987. On the run, Bumblebee finds refuge in a junkyard in a small Californian beach town. Charlie, on the cusp of turning 18, discovers Bumblebee, battle-scarred and broken. When Charlie re-views him, she quickly learns this is no ordinary, yellow VW bug.

### **CAN YOU EVER FORGIVE ME? (M) 1h46 Comedy, Drama, Bio**

Melissa McCarthy stars (and shines), as Lee Israel, the best-selling celebrity biographer who made her living in the 1970's and 80's profiling the likes of Katharine Hepburn and Estée Lauder. When Lee found herself unable to get published because she had fallen out of step with the marketplace, she turned her art form to deception.

### **FREE SOLO USA 1h37 Documentary, Sport**

The filmmakers of acclaimed climbing film, Meru follow Alex Honnold over two years as he becomes the first person to ever free solo climb Yosemite's 3000-foot-high El Capitan Wall.

### **GREEN BOOK (M) USA 2h10 Comedy, Drama**

Golden Globe-winning film with Viggo Mortensen as an Italian-American bouncer from the Bronx hired to drive a world-class concert pianist (Mahershala Ali) across the 1960s American South. As this mismatched pair set out on their journey, they must rely on the "Green Book" to guide them to safe establishments in the segregated south – but they'll need more than a book to understand each other.

### **HOW TO TRAIN YOUR DRAGON: THE HIDDEN WORLD (PG) USA 1h44 Animated**

Hiccup and Toothless will finally discover their true destinies: the village chief as ruler of Berk alongside Astrid, and the dragon as leader of his own kind. As both ascend, the darkest threat they've yet faced tests the bonds of their relationship like never before.

### **KUSAMA: INFINITY USA 1h20 Documentary, Subtitles**

Sundance Grand Jury Prize-nominated film celebrating the top-selling female artist in the world, Yayoi Kusama. Her notoriety with her avant-garde began in New York in 1958 – but with little success. Stymied by sexism and racism, other artists adopted her ideas but failed to acknowledge her contribution. In spite of it all, she has created a legacy of artwork that spans painting, sculpture, installation art, performance art, poetry, and novels. Now in her 80s, and still making art, Kusama has lived the last 30 years in a mental institution in Japan.

### **MARY QUEEN OF SCOTS (R13) UK 2h04 Drama, Historical**

Mary Stuart, Queen of France at 16 and widowed at 18, defies pressure to remarry. Instead, she returns to her native Scotland to reclaim her rightful throne. But Scotland and England fall under the rule of the compelling Elizabeth I. Rivals in power and in love, and female regents in a masculine world, the two must decide how to play the game of marriage versus independence. Betrayal, rebellion, and conspiracies within each court imperil both thrones—and determine history.

### **MORTAL ENGINES (M) NZ, USA 2h08 Science Fiction**

In a world thousands of years in the future. Earth's cities now roam the globe on huge wheels, devouring each other in a struggle for ever-diminishing resources. Adaptation of Philip Reeve's sci-fi novel series, written by Peter Jackson & Fran Walsh.

### **SPIDER-MAN: INTO THE SPIDER-VERSE (PG) USA 1h57 Action, Animation**

Miles is juggling life between being a high school student and being Spider-Man. When another Spiderman winds up in Miles' dimension he trains Miles to become a better Spider-Man. But soon they're joined by four others. As all these clashing dimensions start to tear Brooklyn apart, Miles must help return order.

### **STORM BOY (PG) Australia 1h49 Drama**

A beautiful and contemporary retelling of Colin Thiele's classic Australian tale. 'Storm Boy' has grown up to be Michael Kingley, a successful retired businessman and grandfather. When Kingley starts to see images from his past that he can't explain, he is forced to remember his long-forgotten childhood. He recounts to his grand-daughter the story of how he rescued and raised an extraordinary orphaned pelican.

**THE CHILDREN ACT (M) UK 1h45 Drama** Emma Thompson stars in this morally complex legal drama based on Ian McEwan's acclaimed novel about a judge forced to determine a child's fate.

**THE FAVOURITE (R13) Ireland, UK, USA 2h Comedy, Drama, Biography** In early 18th century England, a frail Queen Anne occupies the throne and her close friend, Lady Sarah, governs the country in her stead. When a new servant, Abigail, arrives, her charm endears her to Sarah. Stars Olivia Colman, Rachel Weisz and Emma Stone.
