A DOGS WAY HOME (PG) 1h36 Adventure, Family

A dog travels 400 miles throughout the Colorado wilderness in search of her owner. Along the way, she meets a series of new friends and manages to bring a little bit of comfort and joy to their lives.

BOHEMIAN RHAPSODY (M) USA, UK 2h14 Drama, Biography

A foot-stomping celebration of Queen and their extraordinary lead singer, Freddie Mercury. Their meteoric rise, near-implosion and reunion on the eve of Live Aid, as Mercury faces a life-threatening illness.

CAPERNAUM (M) Lebanon, France, USA 2h Drama, Subtitles

While serving a five-year sentence for a violent crime, a rebellious 12-year-old boy sues his parents for neglect. Cannes Jury Prize-winner.

CELIA NZ 1h40 Documentary

In this emotionally-charged, lovingly-made documentary, social advocate Celia Lashlie talks openly about her life, her work and her dreams of a better New Zealand.

COLD WAR (M) Poland, France, UK 1h24 Drama, Romance, Historical Subtitles. A passionate romance between two mismatched people, set in 1950s Cold War Poland. Wiktor, a jazz-loving pianist and musical director meets young singer Zula, and is captivated. Multi-award winner, Best Director at Cannes 2018, Pawel Pawlikowski.

COLETTE (M) UK, USA, Hungary 1h51 Drama, True Story & Bio

After marrying a successful Parisian writer, rural born Colette is convinced by her husband to ghost-write for him. Her semi-autobiographical novel about a witty and brazen country girl, sparks a bestseller, further novels and a cultural sensation. Colette's fight over creative ownership and gender roles drives her to overcome societal constraints, revolutionizing literature, fashion and sexual expression.

GREEN BOOK (M) USA 2h10 Comedy, Drama

2019 Academy Best Picture and Best Original Screenplay: Viggo Mortensen as an Italian-American bouncer from the Bronx hired to drive a world-class concert pianist (Mahershala Ali - best supporting Actor) across the 1960s segregated American South.

MAKING THE GRADE Ireland 1h25 Documentary

This endearing and uplifting documentary explores the bond between piano teachers and their pupils as they prepare for and struggle through musical exams.

MARY QUEEN OF SCOTS (R13) UK 2h04 Drama, Historical

Mary Stuart, Queen of France and Elizabeth I: rivals in power and in love, must decide how to play the game of marriage versus independence. Betrayal, rebellion, and conspiracies within each court imperil both thrones - and determine history.

MET OPERA: MARNIE 2h52 Nico Muhly

A gripping reimagining of Winston Graham's novel set in the 1950s; a beautiful, mysterious young woman who assumes multiple identities.

NT LIVE: THE MADNESS OF KING GEORGE III (M) 3h30 1786 - With the King's mind unravelling ambitious politicians and the scheming Prince of Wales threaten to undermine the power of the Crown.

THE HAPPY PRINCE (M) Germany, Belgium, UK, Italy 1h45 Drama, Biography Subtitles Rupert Everett's directorial debut chronicles the untold story of an ailing Oscar Wilde's last days while exiled in France. As Oscar lies on his death bed, he recalls his past with wit and irony. Was he once the most famous man in London? Everett stars alongside Colin Firth and Emily Watson.

STAN & OLLIE (PG) 1h37 Comedy, Drama, True Story & Bio

Steve Coogan and John C. Reilly play comedy duo Laurel and Hardy in this biopic that covers the 1953 British variety hall tour. As attention builds, so too do old resentments, as they are joined by 'the wives', Lucille and Ida.

STORM BOY (PG) Australia 1h49 Drama

A beautiful and contemporary retelling of Colin Thiele's classic Australian tale. Michael Kingley recounts to his grand-daughter the story of how he rescued and raised an extraordinary orphaned pelican.

THE FAVOURITE (R13) Ireland, UK, USA 2h Comedy, Drama, Biography In early 18th century England, a frail Queen Anne occupies the throne and her close friend, Lady Sarah, governs the country in her stead. When a new servant, Abigail, arrives, her charm endears her to Sarah. Stars Olivia Colman, Rachel Weisz and Emma Stone.

THE GUILTY (M) Denmark 1h25 Thriller Subtitles

Set entirely in an Emergency call centre, Asger Holm, a demoted cop with a bad attitude springs attentively to life after receiving a call from a distressed mother who claims she's been kidnapped by her violent ex-husband. High suspense in this Audience Award winner at Sundance.

VICE (M) USA 2h12 Drama, True Story & Biography

The epic story of how Dick Cheney, a bureaucratic Washington insider quietly became one of the most powerful men in the world as Vice President to George W. Bush, reshaping the U.S. and the globe in ways that we still feel today. Stars Christian Bale.
